## **Reading Reflection From One of our Own The descent of the Holy Spirit. ---** (by: Agustin G.)

Today the Church celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples of Jesus in the upper room in Jerusalem. This event of Pentecost marks the beginning of the Church. It is a gift of God to humanity that fulfills the promise of Jesus to His disciples of sending a Helper, an Advocate, to make them His witnesses throughout the world. Jesus breathed on them the Holy Spirit, saying, "As the Father sent me, so I send you," which mirrors the act of God breathing life into Adam. And to continue the work that He had begun, Jesus added, "When the Advocate who proceeds from the Father comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, He will testify to me and guide you into the whole truth. Everything the Father has is mine, and the Spirit takes from what is mine and gives it to **vou**." (cf. Jn 15: 26; 20: 21-23) The Baptism cleanses the Original Sin, the Sacrament of Penance forgives our personal sins, and in the Sacrament of the Eucharist the Holy Spirit starts a new Creation between God and the faithful members of the Body of Christ.
